A Few Topics To Be Aware Of

Cell Phone Policy: When members and guests enter the Club, we ask that phones immediately be turned to silent or vibrate. Cell phone use for verbal communication is not permitted in the clubhouse including the front circle drop off area outside the front door. Cell phones may be used in the locker rooms or the automobile section of the parking lot. In the Bar area only, silent hand held activity – i.e. texting, sharing photos, etc. -- is permitted on a discrete basis. Please be respectful of those dining in near proximity. Cell phones should be kept in inconspicuous locations, i.e. not on dining tables. Wearable technology should not be used for verbal communication purposes, i.e. apple phone watches and bluetooth earpieces.

Smoking Policy: Smoking is not permitted anywhere in or near the clubhouse except in the designated smoking area, which is located on the side porch overlooking the practice range toward the end of the Bar. Smoking urns are available on this porch. Smoking is not permitted at the front entrance of the Club.

Attire:

Dining and Social --Sport casual dress is required throughout the clubhouse unless otherwise announced for evening or other social events. Jackets are required for gentlemen at Sunday dinners November through March. Clean white jeans are permitted for women. Tee shirts, tanks tops, blue jeans, cargo shorts, sweatshirts, hooded sweatshirts, athletic warm-up gear and short shorts are not permitted at Sunnybrook. As tradition has it, on Friday Pub night's only, clean blue jeans free of holes, tears or patches may be worn. Gentlemen may not wear open-toed shoes or sandals at Sunnybrook. Women may wear dress sandals. No flip-flops or rubber-soled sandals are permitted. "No cover under cover"; Hats may not be worn anywhere in the clubhouse. Hats are to be worn with the bill of the hat facing forward. Ladies may wear dress hats.

Golf and Sports --Gentlemen must wear collared shirts at all times and shirttails should be tucked in. Collared shirts are preferred for women; however, tops that are appropriate golf attire will be acceptable. When wearing shorts, men's shorts should be no higher than 3 inches from the top of the knee. Women's shorts and golf skirts should be golf appropriate. On the tennis courts; players are to wear proper tennis attire. No hard-soled shoes are to be worn at any time.

Pace of Play – Pace is historically not an issue at Sunnybrook. Pace of play is governed more by etiquette than time. The quieter nature of play lends itself to slower groups letting faster groups play through.

Directions

PA. TURNPIKE FROM EAST - Exit at Ambler/Philadelphia/309 (Fort Washington interchange). Follow exit ramp past entrance for Rt. 309. Ramp will turn into Pennsylvania Avenue. Follow Pennsylvania Avenue (pass Holiday Inn on left, Mercedes Benz of Ft. Washington on left) to Bethlehem Pike. Make left on Bethlehem Pike and go approximately 2 blocks (over Railroad Pass, you will pass Cantina Feliz/ Rich's Deli on your right). At the next traffic light Lafayette Avenue Connector make a right. Follow that around you will come to a traffic light at Lafayette Avenue, make a left. Continue on Lafayette Avenue when crossing over Skippack Pike (Rt. 73) road name will change to Joshua Road. Continue on Joshua crossing Militia Hill Road (stop sign) to next light, which is Stenton Avenue. Make right on Stenton Avenue. Sunnybrook is the 1st driveway on the left.

PA. TURNPIKE FROM WEST - Exit at Norristown interchange. Take exit ramp to Germantown Pike. Make right on to Germantown Pike (heading towards Lafayette Hill). At 3rd traffic light, turn left on to Joshua Road (you will see WAWA on right corner and Miles Park on the left corner). Follow Joshua (you will cross over Flourtown Road) to the second light (Stenton Avenue) and make left on Stenton. Sunnybrook is the 1st driveway on the left.

SCHUYLKILL EXPRESSWAY FROM PHILADELPHIA- Take the Schuylkill (I-76) west to the Plymouth Meeting exit (exit 331B - 476 north). Follow 476 north to Plymouth Road exit (exit 20). Make right turn on to Plymouth Road and continue to first traffic light (.3 miles). Cross over Butler Pike and continue on Flourtown Road. At first light make a left onto Joshua Road. Continue to first light and make a left onto Stenton Avenue. Sunnybrook is the 1st driveway on the left

I-95 TO 476- Take I-95 north to 476 north to Plymouth Road (exit 20). Make a right turn on Plymouth Road and continue to first traffic light (.3 miles). Cross over Butler Pike and continue on Flourtown Road. At first light make a left onto Joshua Road. Continue to first light and make a left onto Stenton Avenue. Sunnybrook is the 1st driveway on the left.
